

The UA-Cossatot/UAF 2+2 **Agricultural Education, Communication & Technology-Agricultural Education** Transfer Degree Program is a 2+2 Bachelor's Degree program wherein the first two (2) years of study shall be completed at UA-Cossatot, and last two years of study shall be completed at UAF. Students who are going to participate in this program shall be undergraduate students registered at UA-Cossatot who are pursuing an associate of science degree in Agriculture Business.

Admission Process

- The student must complete the requirements necessary for general admission to the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville.
- The student will have earned the Associate of Science degree in Agriculture Education at UA-Cossatot.
- The student must declare a major in Agricultural Education, Communication & Technology-Agricultural Education at UA-Fayetteville.

Students who wish to participate in this program must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 for their coursework at UA-Cossatot. Students will need to enroll and completed pre-approved courses with satisfactory grades to be admitted to the UA-Cossatot/UAF 2+2 Agricultural Education, Communication & Technology-Agricultural Education Transfer Degree Program. Any courses taken outside of the pre-approved list may not be counted to qualify for admittance to the UA-Cossatot/UAF 2+2 Agricultural Education, Communication & Technology-Agricultural Education Transfer Degree Program.
