Students must apply to the UA Office of Teacher Education during their freshman year at NWACC to begin monitoring of required test scores and background checks that will be required during the program application process.

Students should apply for admission into the UA Elementary Education (ELEL) 4 year program by September 15th of their sophomore year at NWACC. Students should also apply to the UA for Admissions at this time as well.

Last 10 hours of degree requirements will be completed at UA and transferred back to NWACC for degree completion.
